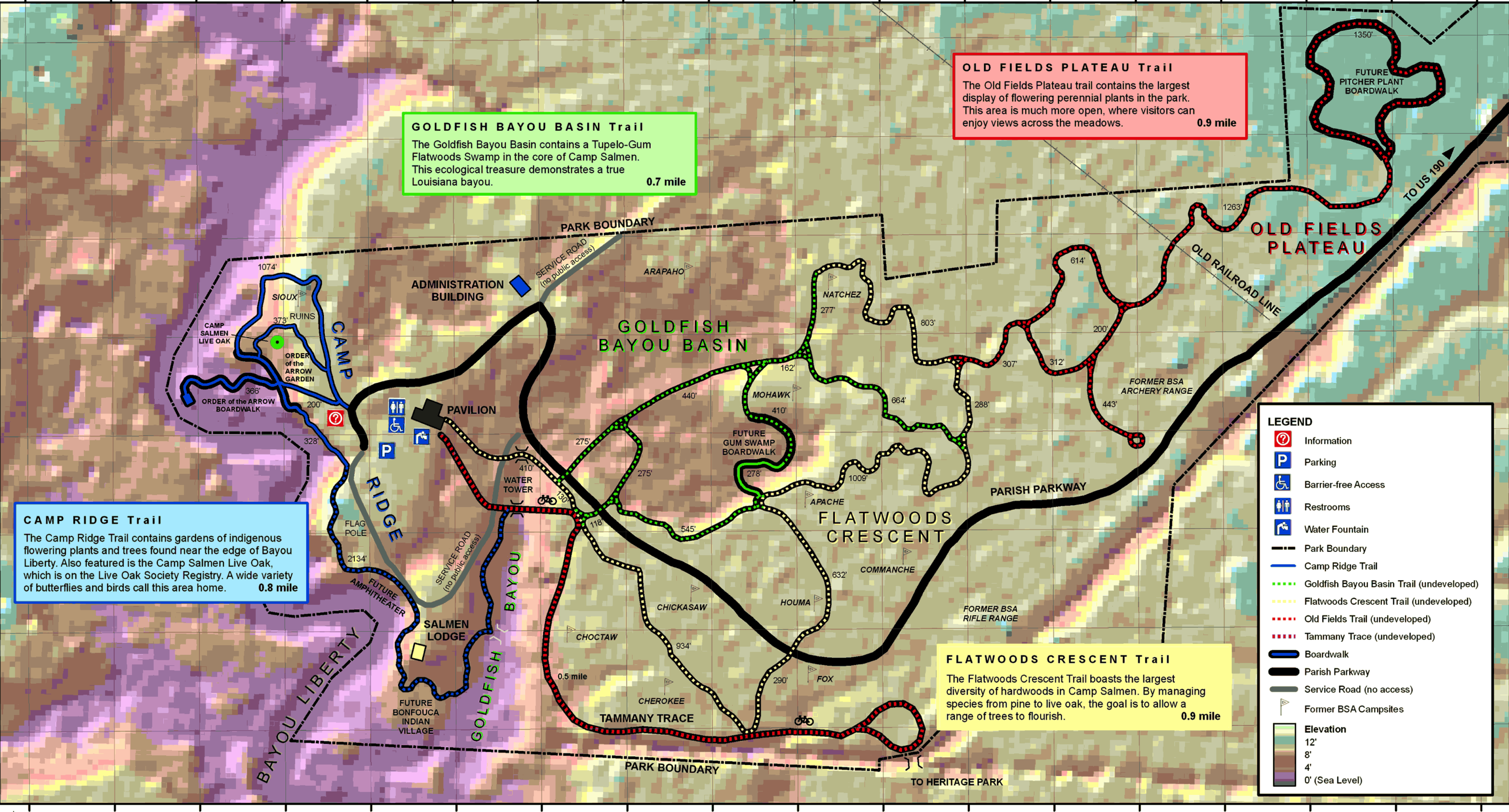

GOLDFISH BAYOU BASIN Trail
 The Goldfish Bayou Basin contains a Tupelo-Gum Flatwoods Swamp in the core of Camp Salmen. This ecological treasure demonstrates a true Louisiana bayou. **0.7 mile**

OLD FIELDS PLATEAU Trail
 The Old Fields Plateau trail contains the largest display of flowering perennial plants in the park. This area is much more open, where visitors can enjoy views across the meadows. **0.9 mile**

CAMP RIDGE Trail
 The Camp Ridge Trail contains gardens of indigenous flowering plants and trees found near the edge of Bayou Liberty. Also featured is the Camp Salmen Live Oak, which is on the Live Oak Society Registry. A wide variety of butterflies and birds call this area home. **0.8 mile**

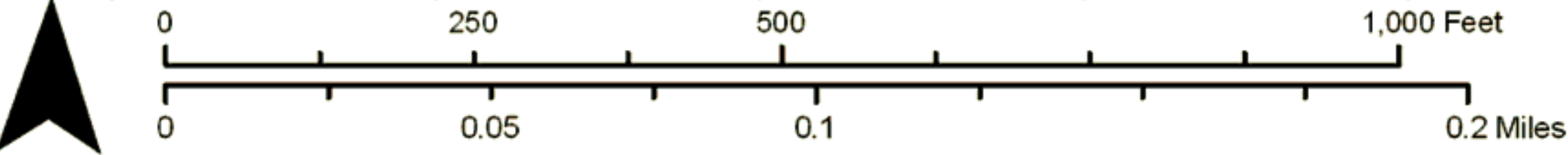
FLATWOODS CRESCENT Trail
 The Flatwoods Crescent Trail boasts the largest diversity of hardwoods in Camp Salmen. By managing species from pine to live oak, the goal is to allow a range of trees to flourish. **0.9 mile**
